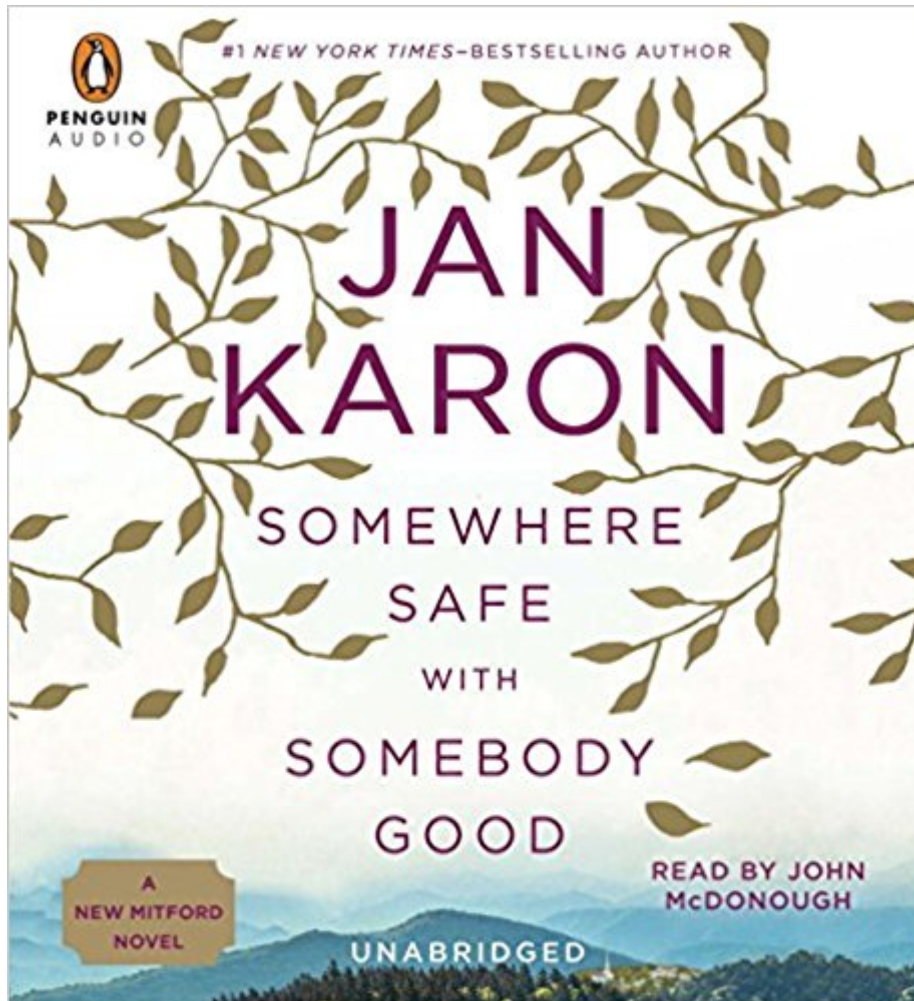

Mitford and it's cast of quirky, but lovable townspeople have other ideas. The new priest, Father Talbot, fights inner demons that lead to his own demise. Of course Father Tim is called to be his replacement till Father Bob from Colorado can come in. Will Father Tim take on this challenge? Will he give up "retirement" to honor this request? Sammy, Dooley's youngest brother is angry and sharing that anger with all that cross his path. That he lives next door in Father's Tim's home in the basement with his brothers, puts a conundrum at Father's Tim next door step. Helene, who rents out the basement, is calling for Sammy's dismissal and runs to Father Tim to come up with a solution for her dilemma.
